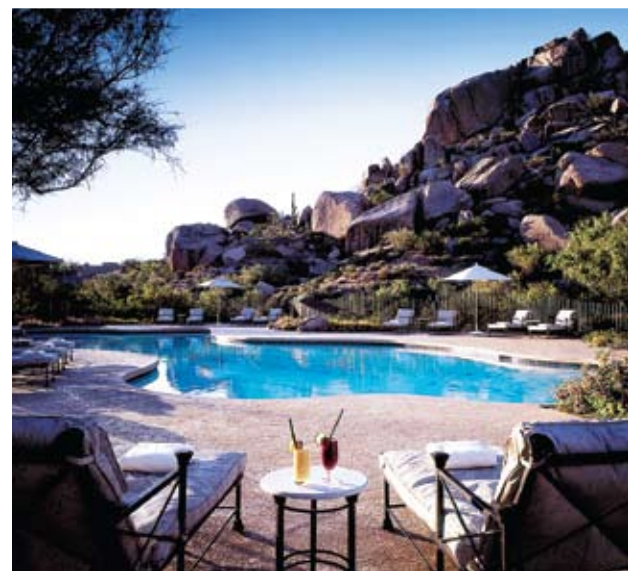




AN INSPIRING OASIS

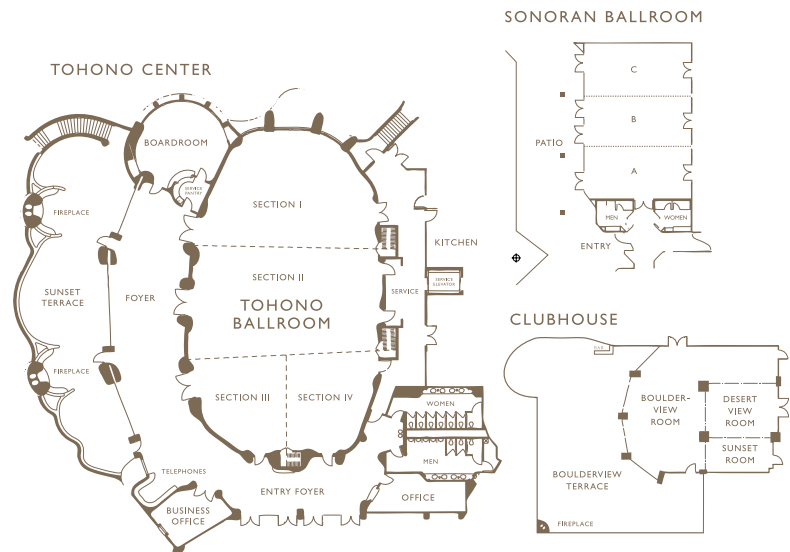
