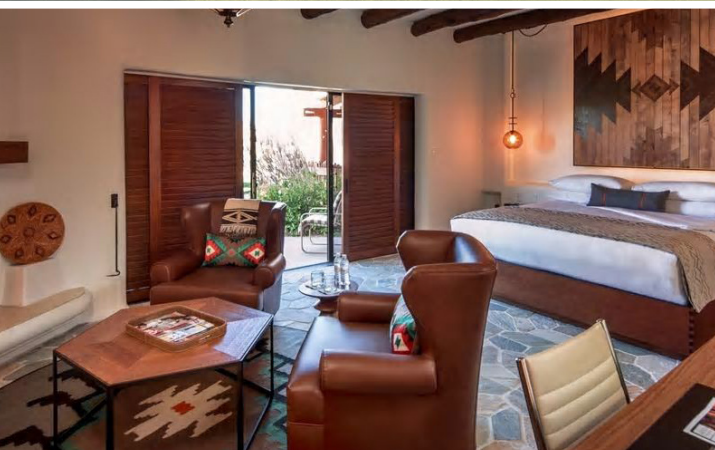

## LOCATION

The Boulders Resort & Spa is nestled in the tranquil beauty of the high Sonoran Desert foothills on 1,300 acres.

## DESCRIPTION

Dramatic architecture blends with the surrounding desert and 12 million-year-old boulder formations to reveal our resort that includes restaurants, clubhouse, lounge and the 160 casitas all complete with private patios. There are three Executive Board Suites. We also offer 54 one, two, and three-bedroom Villas, 5 luxury Hacienda homes, and the five-bedroom, 5,000 square foot Villa Retreat.

## SERVICES & AMENITIES

- Two 18-hole Jay Morrish designed golf courses.
- Tennis Garden with 3 premier and 4 asphalt tennis courts, and 4 pickleball courts.
- Five on-site restaurants range from American Classics, Southwestern Cuisine, and Mexican fare to a healthy Spa Café.
- The 33,000 sq. ft. Boulders Spa features 24 treatment rooms and a fully equipped Fitness Center.
- Surrender to serenity at the private labyrinth (path to tranquility, meditation) in the authentic Tipi, and the inspirational setting of the Organic Garden with flowing water and a reflection pond.
- The latest technology features such as upgraded televisions, audio systems, internet services and more.
- Access to the Resort Pool, the adult pool at Spa, the Club Pool, and the four Jacuzzis.
- Experience the Boulder Rock Climb, Hot-Air Ballooning, Desert Jeep, ATV or Hummer tour, Horseback riding, Desert hiking, Sonoran Explorin Tour, and much more.
- Activities for all ages include bicycle tours, lawn chess, desert fly fishing, desert photo tours and Walk the Rock walking tours.

## RESORT FEE

A Resort Fee of \$35USD per room per day plus tax at 14.02% will apply to all guest rooms utilized. This fee, in lieu of cash gratuities, includes daily newspaper, high-speed wireless internet, gratuities for bell staff (including portage), on-property drivers, pool attendants, concierge, and all other service personnel (*excludes food and beverage gratuities*). This nightly service charge also includes a daily membership to the spa. This membership allows access to the locker room and all the amenities, full use of weight room and cardio room, fitness classes, access to the sauna, steam room and Spa Pool area, Niwa, Labyrinth, and access to the Spa Café (*excludes treatments and salon services*).

## TRANSPORTATION

The Boulders is located 33 miles (53.11 Kilometers) / 40 minutes north of Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport. Corporate jets, up to G4 level, may prefer the Scottsdale Airport, or Deer Valley Airport which are 15 miles (24.14 Kilometers) / 20 minutes drive.

Situated in the high Sonoran desert, the area is surrounded by extraordinary granite rock formations, mountains and lush desert flora. With an average annual temperature of 69°F combined with the low humidity, the desert provides summer temperatures that are unexpectedly mild.
